Scholarships and Grants

Most MU scholarships and grants may be used for MU sponsored or partner study abroad programs during a semester. They cannot be used for non-MU programs and during the summer. Tuition and non resident scholarships may be cancelled or reduced if non resident tuition is waived or paid by another source.

Loans

Ford Federal Direct Loans - Must file a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to be eligible. The maximum you can receive per academic year is based on your earned credits hours. \$3500 for those with 1-29 academic credits, \$4500 for those students with 30-59 academic credits and \$5500 for those with 60+ academic credits.
