Global Heritage Scholarship

The following policies govern the Global Heritage Scholarship at the University of Missouri - Columbia. To remain eligible for the award, recipients must:

1. Enroll at the University of Missouri-Columbia (MU) the first semester following graduation from high school.
2. Remain continuously enrolled at MU for each regular (Fall and Spring) semester.
3. Enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester and complete at least 24 graded credit hours each academic year at MU.
4. Maintain a cumulative MU grade point average of 3.25 or better to renew the scholarship each year.

The renewal criteria above are reviewed in May at the end of each academic year.

The scholarship may be used for a maximum of 8 regular semesters or until you receive a bachelor's degree, whichever comes first. The renewal requirements will be evaluated at the end of the winter semester each year.

Failure to meet the renewal criteria will cause the recipient to be ineligible to receive the scholarship for the following academic year. If at the end of that academic year the renewal criteria listed above are met, the scholarship will be reinstated for the next academic year. However, all semesters of enrollment are counted toward the 8 semester limit of receiving the award.

The scholarship pays for 100% of the nonresident fees charged for enrollment. It does not, however, pay for any other educational or enrollment fee. For a list of fees please refer to the MU Cashier's Office website at <http://www.missouri.edu/~forcash/>.

The scholarship may be used during the summer semester but the student must request in writing to use the funds in the summer. However, if the written request is approved, using the award during a summer semester will count as one full semester of eligibility used regardless of the number of credit hours earned during that semester.

The Global Heritage Scholarship is not transferable among the campuses of the University of Missouri system.

Exceptions to any of the above policies must be requested in writing.
