Missouri Community College Phi Theta Kappa (PKT) Scholarship

The following policies govern the Missouri Community College PKT Scholarship at the University of Missouri - Columbia. To remain eligible for the award, recipients must:

1. Enroll at the University of Missouri-Columbia (MU) the first regular (Fall and Spring) semester following graduation from a Missouri community college.
2. Remain continuously enrolled at MU for each regular (Fall and Spring) semester.
3. Enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester and complete at least 24 graded credit hours each academic year at MU.
4. Maintain a cumulative MU grade point average of 3.25 or better.

The renewal criteria above are reviewed in May at the end of each academic year.

The scholarship may be used for a maximum of 4 regular semesters or until receipt of a bachelor's degree, whichever occurs first.

The Missouri Community College PKT Scholarship is not transferable among the campuses of the University of Missouri system.

Exceptions to any of the above policies must be requested in writing.
